

Biosketch

Thorsten Steiner is professor of neurology and neurointensive care. He is chair of the Department of Neurology at Klinikum Frankfurt Höchst and director of the Stroke Unit-Service at Klinikum Hofheim. Prof. Steiner is an Honorary Professor of Copenhagen University, Denmark and member of Medical Faculty at Heidelberg University Hospital, Germany. He holds a title as a Master of Medical Education from Bern University, Switzerland.

Prof. Steiner received his medical training at the University of Heidelberg, the Tanga Regional Medical Centre in Tanzania, and the Johns Hopkins School of Medicine in Baltimore, Maryland, United States. He completed his specialty training in neurology, emergency medicine, and critical care neurology at the University of Heidelberg Hospital.

Prof. Steiner's main research interests are related to stroke intensive care, intracerebral haemorrhage, invasive monitoring, and treatment strategies of elevated intracranial pressure. He has performed several clinical studies on intracerebral haemorrhage, thrombolysis and neuroprotectants in ischaemic stroke as principle investigator and co-investigator.

Prof. Steiner is chairman of the guidelines committee of the European Stroke Organisation (ESO). He has published in such journals as the New England Journal of Medicine, Lancet Neurology, Stroke, Neurology, the Journal of Neurosurgery, Annals of Neurology, and others.
